	Women in Leadership Scholarship Fund (WLSF)
Tender Purpose	The purpose of this tender is to solicit proposals from IPPF Member Associations - in partnership with an external expert agency/organisation - to host and manage the IPPF Women in Leadership Scholarship Fund from August 2021 to December 2023, with scope for extension.
Fund Description	Manifesting gender equality and women's rights, in intent and action, is integral to the goal of shaping a high performing Federation. Making IPPF, in all its forms, a great place to work, where women trust that they will have equal opportunities for professional growth and leadership - irrespective of age, disability, race, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, or social status - will positively impact on organisational culture(s), effectiveness and delivery.
	The Advancement of Women in Leadership Scholarship will mitigate and address the professional biases and other barriers that hinder women's professional growth, and help women strengthen their knowledge-base and build career paths. The scholarship will target women occupying positions of leadership within the Federation, whether mid or senior level in operational, strategic or governance roles.
	 The scholarships will be provided for advanced degrees/diplomas or certification at accredited universities, colleges, or other institutes of higher learning, in a relevant field in line with job role. The following roles are envisaged for the managing MA and external expert partner agency/organisation:
	 Develop guidance in accordance with mutually agreed criteria Develop a user-friendly application platform Launch calls for proposals Ensure a transparent and representative selection processes Provide ongoing support for the fund applicants Conduct seminars about ongoing research or thematic issue related to management and leadership



	 Disseminate learning and thinking emerging from the programme.
Expected Results	 Outcome: women, girls, and youth, at all levels of the Federation, are supported to boost their leadership capacity, though the provision of scholarships, organising of seminars and dissemination of learning. Output Indicators: # of scholarships

Total Budget (including estimated overheads and indirect cost)	The total available budget for the management of the scholarship fund is USD 150,000. This amount includes all costs for staffing, monitoring, reporting and overheads. The total activity budget (including scholarships) is USD 500,000.
Criteria for Application	 Accredited IPPF Member Association and one external expert agency/organisation. No qualified organisational audits in the last two years Annual turnover higher than total tendered funds Proven excellence in one or more of the following areas: Intersectional feminism; 2. Regranting; 3. Fund management; 4. Institutional learning.
