Survivor centered approach; Provide or ensure referral for clinical care and psychosocial support for survivors; Coordinate with GBV cluster on prevention measures

2.MISP

PREVENT SEXUAL VIOLENCE AND RESPOND TO SURVIVORS

IPES

Appoint MISP focus person in MA/branch; attend health and protection cluster (with SRH and GBV subcluster); coordinate and collaborate with other stakeholders including CSOs working with marginalised populations

1.MISP COORDINATION

IPES
(DEPENDING ON MA CAPACITY)

Assess own resources (staff capacity, finance, supply etc) and possible partner for collaboration. Plan when and how to extend SRH services after all MISP objectives are fulfilled

PLAN FOR COMPREHENSIVE SERVICES
AS SOON AS POSSIBLE

IPES (DEPENDING ON MA)

Accessibility and acceptability of quality services for youth/ adolescent, PLD, LGBTQI

MISP
EXPLICITLY RECOGNISED IN MISP

MISP = Minimum Initial Service Package

PMTCT = Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission

PLD = People Living with disabilities
