## **Agenda Item:** THE YOUTH FORUM RESOLUTION TO THE 2022 GA

## **Summary:**

The new Strategy of IPPF has a strong commitment to youth action in our mission to advance sexual and reproductive health and rights for all, especially those in marginalized and excluded communities. We live in a time where youth is the most diverse generation in terms of ethnicity, race, sexuality and gender identity.<sup>1</sup>

Responding to the active participation of youth delegates from member associations prior and at the General Assembly, the Board of Trustees has requested 10 specific actions. Progress is presented in this document.
